Maharishi Balmiki Viklang Evam Anath KalyanSavashram Sanstha orphanage in Ranchi

In early 2019, Bringing Life Home began working to improve conditions at the Maharishi Balmiki orphanage in Ranchi, Jharkhand, which houses 50 children aged 5 to 14. With donor support, the organization renovated the facility's nine rooms — adding proper doors, windows, and crucial bathroom upgrades — to create a safer, more functional environment. A charity paint night event held later that year helped raise awareness and additional funds, significantly enhancing the children's quality of life.
